A huge THANK YOU to all who helped put the exhibition together, especially the Exhibition Committee and Exhibition Coordinator, Graham Baker, for the hard work and many hours of organisation. Special thanks also to Judge Megan Lavin-McIssac, Editor, The New Zealand Artist Magazine.

Workshop/ Timetable Update



Lyn Watts Travel Sketching; enrolment forms have been sent out. Don't forget that spaces in these classes will go to the first people who pay their enrolment fee. This class does have a limited number of spaces, so if you are unsuccessful, there will probably be another session later in the year.

Graham Baker Workshop; the expression of interest form is filling up. You can either put your name on the form in the Foyer or email me. Hopefully there will be enough interest for the class to go ahead in August.

Extra Timetable session Monday 31st July 9.30am- 4.00pm - this will be an exploration of Value.

You will need to bring:

Pencils; White pencil in the form of Charcoal pencil, pastel pencil, conte stick, or chalk for drawing out shapes – bring what you have; glue; scissors; paper to glue shapes onto. Toned paper will be supplied. (We will be cutting out shapes of differing values and gluing them onto paper).

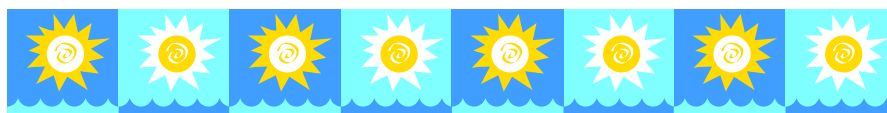
Canvas strips or gessoed paper or cardboard. The strips need to be 3cm wide and 27cm long – mark into 9 3cm squares. Any colour paints plus Black and White (we will be making up a 9-stage value strip that you can use to evaluate your colours).

A Piece of Canvas or cardboard capable of being divided into 6x 13cm by 20cm rectangles and painted in black, white and shades of grey.

Don't forget to fill out the Expression of interest forms for our other workshops. There will soon be more information about these classes.
