Duties of Librarian are as follows:-

- To receive, review and process all books/DVDs/magazines donated to the Library by members of the public or Society Members.
- To advise Executive Committee immediately of any such donation so it may be acknowledged.
- To catalogue and file any books/DVDs/magazines that are suitable for the library.
- To liaise with the Executive Committee regarding:
 - a) Donations of books not required for the Library.
 - b) Items that may be duplicated, out of date and no longer useful which could be culled from the library if overstocking occurs.
(A decision will then be made by the Committee as to whether items remain in the library or are kept for a future society art sale, placed on sales table in clubrooms, stored elsewhere or given to another charitable organisation.)
- To recommend to the Executive Committee purchase of any new book/DVD or magazine subscription for the Library.
- To submit a monthly report to the Newsletter Editor by the due date.
- To submit a monthly report to the Executive Committee for their meeting.
- To repair any damaged books.
- To maintain the library in a neat and tidy condition.
- To assist with any members requiring help with choosing a book.
- To maintain a record of items borrowed from the library and follow up on any overdue or missing items.

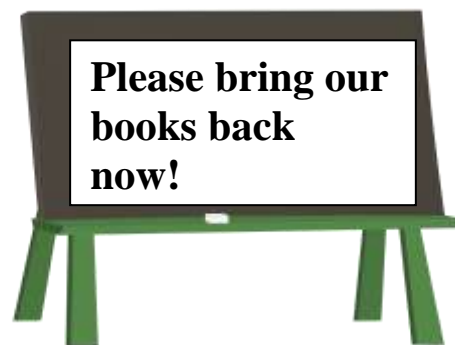

End of Year Competitions

The Society end of year competitions will be held on **Saturday 25th November**. The Judges will be **Bryce Brown** and **Dave Roy**.



The Categories and Awards are outlined below with their definitions:

1. **Reg Charman Memorial Cup- Theme “Cutting Edge” chosen by the Executive Committee.** Any medium.
2. **President’s Trophy – Best Emerging Artist** (of up to 2 years as an artist - not just 2 years at TSA) – **chosen by the Executive Committee – Theme “Sunshine”.**
3. **Marie Peters Millennium Cup – Best Pastel.** Any theme using soft, hard pastels, pastel pencils or oil pastels.
4. **Grace Walsh Trophy – Best Oil.** Any theme using oils.
5. **Georgina Don Memorial Award – Best Acrylic.** Any theme using acrylics.
6. **Marge Martin Salver – Tauranga Scene.** Work in any medium on a theme associated with Tauranga city or suburbs - within the city boundaries and recognisable as such.
7. **Carter Brothers Award – Best Watercolour.** Any theme using watercolours (tube, cake or watercolour pencils with light wash) continued.....
8. **Cam Burgoyne Thomas Memorial Award + Keith Corner Memorial Trophy. Best Abstract.** Does not depict a person, place or thing in the natural world. The forms make no reference to visible reality.
9. **Jensen Trophy – Best Coloured Pencil.** Any theme using coloured pencils (no washes).

10. The Contemporary Art Trophy – any theme, any medium. The art of today - a reflection of modern day life.

Note: Definitions of categories can be found on the whiteboard.

Please bring your paintings to the Elizabeth Street, Community Centre

8.30 – 9.00 am 25 November. Cover your name on the front but have swing tag on the back.

COMPETITION RULES for November 25th 2017

1. All entries to have been completed within the 12 months prior to the competition.
2. Entries must be entirely the member's own work and not done in a class of instruction, or copied from publications or photographs taken by other people without their written permission.
3. Entries must be presented in a finished, dry condition, framed or otherwise finished ready for hanging, with D rings and cord, or finished in a stable mount with a rigid backing - able to be supported and hung.
4. All entries must have the name of the member, and the category/competition being entered, securely attached to the back of the work on a swing tag long enough to go over the top of the painting and hang in front of the work. The member's name to be covered on the front, if the work is signed.
5. **One entry per category** will be accepted, unless otherwise stated by the competition co-ordinator.
6. Airbrushed works of art will be accepted, but must be labelled as airbrushed in its medium category. If a painting is part airbrushed and part painting, it must be labelled as Mixed media/Airbrush in its Medium category.
7. All competing members must be financial.
8. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet these criteria.
9. All entries are to remain on display until 12.45pm. Artists may collect their paintings only after 12.45pm.



For paintings which would normally be behind glass and framed (such as watercolour, pastel etc.) **Krystal Clear sleeves in two sizes are available.** We are trialling these as an alternative to expensive framing and these can be obtained from Liz Cross for a nominal fee. There are two sizes small and medium. The small size is 37cm x 29cm at \$1.00 each and the large is 55cm x 40cm at \$2.50 each. **Liz can be contacted by email p.cros@xtra.co.nz.** By using a sleeve with a rigid backing and a stable mount you will ensure your work will be displayed to its best advantage.
